## Allergies, Adrenaline Auto-Injectors and Antihistamines

We are writing to you as our records show that your child is registered as having an allergy. To make sure we have the correct information in school to treat your child if they have an allergic reaction, we are asking for you to send us an Allergy Action sheet completed by your child's Healthcare Professional. This will tell us if your child uses an Adrenaline-Auto Injector, Jext, or antihistamines.

We have attached copies of the forms on our website which can only be completed by a Healthcare professional. If you already have a completed form, please send it in to us.

If your child is allergic to penicillin or any other prescription medication then we would not need this form as a reaction should not happen in school as no medication would be administered in school, however it will be recorded on their school record so we have up to date information should we need it.

Food allergies that need to be treated with the aforementioned medication will need a completed form.

Children who suffer from Hayfever during the summer months will normally take an antihistamine in the morning to combat this. On occasion a sufferer will need prescription medication so in that instance please send in a completed form.

Pink medical passes will now only be issued to students with severe allergies that need rescue medication as indicated on the form.
