RE: Year 9 Parents Evening 15th January 2026

Year 9 Parents Evening will be held on Thursday 15th January 2026 from 2.30pm until 6.50pm. This is a vital parents evening that will provide you with information regarding your child's option choices ready to start their GCSE courses in year 10.

You are now able to book your appointments via the School Cloud booking system using the following link <https://coopfailsworth.schoolcloud.co.uk/>

During the evening you will:

- Meet with your child's English, Maths and Science teachers for a progress update. (please use the booking link above to book these.)
- Attend one of four options talks delivered by Mrs Brodrick, Deputy Headteacher. These will be delivered at 3pm, 4pm, 5pm and 6pm. (Please factor the talk into your visit, tannoy announcements will be made prior to each talk held in the theatre)
- Visit departments of subject areas that you would like to find out more about to support you making your options choices. (Booking for this part of the evening is not necessary - please go to the subject area corridor to speak with department staff)

During the evening you will meet with teachers from English, Maths and Science. They will be providing a progress update as these subjects are compulsory at GCSE and students will be continuing their studies in these subjects.

In addition you will have the opportunity to visit all departments that your child is thinking about choosing as an option in year 10. You will be able to find out about the course and subject content including how the courses are examined. Teachers will be based on their department wing.

Finally you will have the opportunity to learn about the options process. There will be 4 presentations taking place at 3pm, 4pm, 5pm and 6pm in our Theatre. Please can you factor these into your schedule when you have made your appointments. We will outline the compulsory curriculum as well as introducing you to the full range of Key Stage 4 options available at the academy.

All meetings with class teachers will take place on department corridors and not in our usual rooms of the sports hall or cafe Mojo. There will be plenty of people on hand to support you in finding your way around the school and you will be provided with a map on arrival so that you can navigate the building. We feel this will allow more efficient appointment times and less crowding.

If you have any difficulty with booking appointments please contact us so that we can support you with navigating the booking system.
